# From first concept to a bankable decision

## The study pathway

Every mining study answers one question with increasing confidence: *should this project be built?* Indicative cost-estimate accuracy ranges align with accepted study-process guidance and the JORC Code (2012).

*An Ore Reserve cannot be reported on a scoping study — at least a pre-feasibility study is required. There are three study stages, not more: the Definitive Feasibility Study (DFS) is the investment-grade stage — also called a Feasibility Study (FS) or Bankable Feasibility Study (BFS), the same final study under different names, not an additional stage.*

### JORC MODIFYING FACTORS

#### What converts a Resource into a Reserve

Under the JORC Code (2012) an Ore Reserve can only be declared once the Modifying Factors have been assessed in at least a pre-feasibility study. We address each of them:

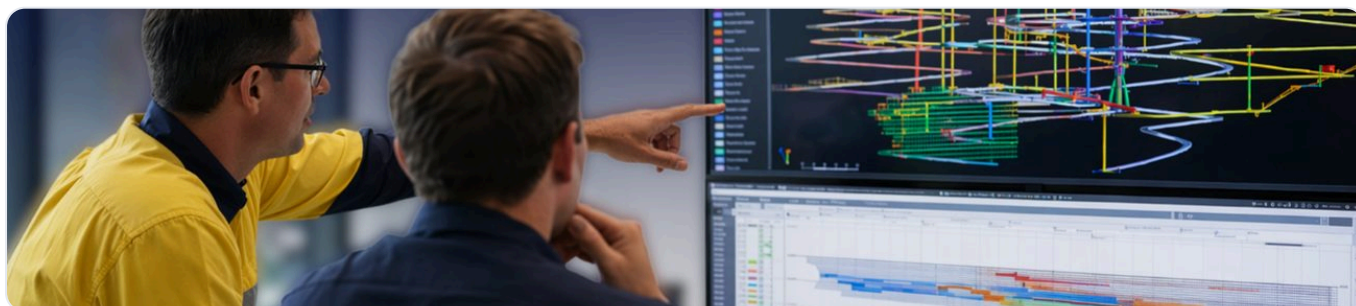
